

## Job Posting – City of Bellingham – General, Water, Sewer Maintenance Worker

The City of Bellingham is in search of a city maintenance worker. Currently, this is a full-time position at 40 hours a week; however, this can be negotiated depending on the candidate

### Key Functions:

- Maintenance and general upkeep of the city's buildings, properties, water distribution system, sanitary sewer system, storm sewer system, streets/alleys, city dump, equipment, etc.
- Sampling and reporting to state agencies when required (water, sewer, etc.).
- Required to keep all licenses and certifications current at all times.
- Mowing/trimming
- Chemical application for weed, mosquitos, etc.
- Snow removal.
- Other duties as detailed out in the City Maintenance job description and as assigned.

### Experience and Education:

- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Must have valid driver license
- Must have or be able to obtain water distribution system license that covers off on the city's water distribution system. (minimum Class C)
- Must have or be able to obtain sanitary sewer license that covers off on the city's sanitary sewer system. (minimum Class D)
- Must have or be able to obtain a CDL.
- Must have or be able to obtain applicators license allowing for spraying weeds, mosquitos, etc. (as required)
- Subject to random drug testing at employer's discretion.
- Basic knowledge of machinery, water/sewer lines, street maintenance and infrastructure, all helpful but not all a requirement.

### Other job requirements:

- Attend monthly council meetings (to give a briefing report)
- Hours may vary and ability to be on call will be necessary (especially during the Winter months).
- Ability to effectively communicate with the City Council and the general public.
- Be a self-starter and can complete tasks in a timely and efficient manner.
- See opportunities for improvement and help the city council plan for future needs and possible opportunities
- Subject to background check
- Must be willing to relocate and live within city limits

### Pay and Benefits:

- Pay is negotiable depending on experience and qualifications.
- 10 paid holidays, paid time off, and ability to comp hours when needed
- Health insurance stipend
